The Pilot International Executive Committee has established a grant to aid Anchor and Compass members in leadership development by attending leadership conferences and other training. This grant is awarded through the Goals for Grants and Awards program of Pilot International Founders Fund.

Dreams Ahead Leadership Grant Application

The Dreams Ahead Grant was established in 2014 to provide financial assistance to Anchor and Compass members who are seeking to develop leadership skills. Applicants are to be Anchor Club members in grades 9-12 or active Compass members.

Grants are based on financial need, community service, and application contents. Grants are given for one academic year. A member may re-apply the following year. Grant amounts may vary.

This application must be received by the Youth Development Specialist electronically by 5pm on March 1st. Submissions should be sent to youthdevelopment@pilothq.org.

Policies for Pilot International Dreams Ahead Leadership Grant

- The Executive Committee of Pilot International will provide the overall administration of the Dreams Ahead Leadership Grant funds. A minimum of 1 Anchor member and 1 Compass member will be awarded grants if funds allow and applications are submitted.
- The Executive Committee, through the Youth Development Specialist, may receive recommendations for awards from any Pilot Club, District, and / or the Executive Committee of Pilot International, in accordance with existing administrative procedures.
- The deadline for local clubs to send their completed Dreams Ahead Leadership
 Grant application packets to the Pilot International Youth Development Specialist is
 5pm est. on March 1st.
- The Pilot International Youth Development Specialist, Pilot International Anchor Coordinator, and Pilot International Compass Coordinator will review and grade award applications and make recommendations to the Executive Committee of Pilot International. They will recommend those persons who are best suited to further the purposes of the fund as recipients of the grant.
- Dreams Ahead Leadership Grant funds may be used for registration fees and other expenses considered necessary by the Executive Committee for the recipient to be able to attend the leadership conference. Actual amounts awarded may vary.
- In accordance with IRS regulations, officers, directors, trustees, employees, or the current staff of Pilot International are not eligible for award programs sponsored by Pilot International.
- When an application has been approved, the sponsoring district will be notified, and payment will be made in one installment directly to the applicant upon receipt of the appropriate forms.
- Once approved, a member may reapply annually by submitting an updated application and supportive documents – if the district elects to continue sponsorship of the member. However, any given member may be awarded a total of three (3)
 Dreams Ahead Grants.
- An Anchor or Compass club may submit only 2 applicants each award period.

Sponsoring District Responsibilities

- Screen applicants. The District PIFF Representative should carefully review the applicant's
 grant request and the application procedures. Districts are strongly encouraged to
 personally interview applicants. Only those applicants who meet or exceed the minimum
 qualifications required by the grant should be recommended for a grant.
- Guarantee that the application is typed or printed.
- Provide the completed original applications and supporting documents, (in the order listed) to the Pilot International Youth Development Specialist via email by 5pm on March 1st.
 - Sponsorship Profile
 - Member Application
 - Member Agreement
 - Summary of Volunteer Service
 - Leadership Essay
 - Checklist
- Make sure the applicant understands the policies governing the grant program and the terms of the Member Agreement and remains aware of its provisions throughout the term of the grant.
- Familiarize the recipient with Pilot International's principles so the member will be a good Pilot ambassador.
- Inform the recipient of the approval / denial of the grant and formally award if possible.
- Work closely with the member to ensure that the payment is requested in time. To
 do this, the member must submit all requested forms to Pilot International.
- Pilot Club members are encouraged to invite the member to at least one club meeting per year. Clubs should also contact the member regularly and assist as needed.

Grant Applications that are incomplete or do not include all of the appropriate documentation will not be processed.
